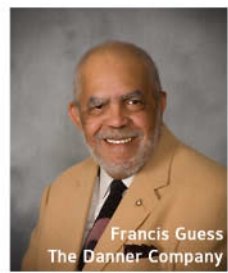

I was born and raised right here in Nashville, TN. I was away for almost 8 years obtaining my education but now I am back home! After I graduated from Hillsboro High School in 2001 I attended the University of Tennessee in Knoxville. Over the summer between high school and college I was asked to move to Barcelona, Spain in at the beginning of the year for a minimum of 1 year on a modeling contract, but the events of September 11th canceled that plan, and I decided to stay in school. I joined the Pi Beta Phi sorority and I received my Bachelor of Science degree in Animal Science and Biology.

I decided to go to chiropractic school for a number of reasons, the most influential of which was a misdiagnosis for hip problems I had experienced since I was 17. It took a few visits to a chiropractor, but eventually I was nearly pain free. I also learned that there was more to my symptoms than just the pain I was feeling. I learned that pain was my body's response to an underlying problem, a structural problem that was putting pressure on the nerves in my hip area. While attending chiropractic school in South Carolina at Sherman College of Chiropractic, I became an ACE intern. ACE stands for Academy of Chiropractic Excellence. It was a very small selective group of students who went above and beyond the expected requirements of interns in the clinic. I was the only girl in the ACE program of only 10 interns.

So that I would have the opportunity to participate in the off campus internship program I finished my graduation requirements a quarter early. My last quarter of school was spent with Dr. Rebecca Pugh, at Maryland Farms Chiropractic, in Brentwood, TN. As soon as I graduated in June of 2010, Dr. Pugh offered me a position to continue working with her as her associate. Since then I have been the Adjusting Doctor at Maryland Farms Chiropractic.

Currently I am in the process of buying my first home, hopefully I will have moved out of my mother's house by this summer. My long distance boyfriend of almost 2 years is planning on moving in with me soon as well.

I love to spend time outdoors in my free time, when the weather is nice. I like to mountain bike and kayak and hike.

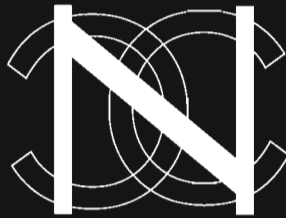
